1. Introductions. Discussion of member's roles and responsibilities.

2. Concerns that community members can bring to council members.
  - Election of a committee chairperson. *Tami Thompson offered to be the chair. Her offer was accepted by all members.*
  - Preferred email address for members they would like posted on the website. *All members will use the emails they have already provided to get communications from the school.*
  - Upcoming training Oct. 25th 6-8 PM *Tammy will attend this state mandated training on October 25<sup>th</sup> with Sharon Jensen.*
  - Approve proposed meeting schedule. *Approved.*
  - Watch the training video from the State Office. *The video was viewed at the end of the meeting in Sharon's office by SCC members who had not seen it before.*

4. Lands Trust Plan 2017/18.  
*All members received a copy of this year's plan and Sharon went over each goal and the monies spent in each area. The outreach aide in Goal #1 has yet to be hired but the job is posted on the district's website and interviews will be soon. This will be a bi-lingual aide to help reach out to parents before students are dropped from Valley due to attendance issues.*

6. Jacinto Peterson –

  - Internet Safety and Digital Citizenship

*Jacinto talked about the school safety plan and the fire drills we have had so far. One more is scheduled before October 1<sup>st</sup> in accordance with state law. He talked about the training the state conducts for digital citizenship and that Josie is a fantastic presenter. Sharon mentioned that he always talks to our students about online foolishness and problems in his Real Talk sessions as a guest speaker.*

7. Comprehensive School Counseling Program – Raylene Glover
- Plan for College & Career Readiness (PCCR) appts. *They are making them now and will be doing these until the end of the quarter. VHS exceeds the amount of PCCR required by the state. Our students need the personal touch.*
  - Service Learning. *Raylene talked about the upcoming walk and the Christmas service project our students do each year.*
  - Data Project – *This year the project is students with attendance issues. We hope to have a school wide intervention for these students.*
  - Pathways to Professions – *is on October 16<sup>th</sup>. We will have about 40 students attend from VHS.*
