2nd Quarter Registration Information

(11th & 12th graders accepted this quarter)

MUST ATTEND

You must attend one of the four orientation meetings to register at Valley.

- Sessions begin promptly.
- Plan on arriving **30 minutes** early to check in. Anyone arriving late will be turned away and must attend a later session.
- You will be at orientation for 2 hours, which includes taking the SRI test.
- Parents are welcome to attend orientation with the student, but are not required to.

NOTE: You will not be allowed to attend any session without all the documents listed to the right in WHAT TO BRING.

FEE INFORMATION

- A registration fee of \$25 is due at the counseling meeting when the student receives a schedule.
- Payment can be made by:
 - Cash
 - Money Order
 - Credit Card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover Card only)
 - **No Checks Accepted**

WHAT TO BRING

- A **referral** to attend Valley High from your boundary high school.
(Jordan or Canyons District - This is usually obtained from your assistant principal.)
- A copy of your **immunization records** and **Birth Certificate**.
- A copy of your **transcripts** with past grades earned.
(These can be unofficial transcripts from 9th grade to current.)

NOTE: If you are a special education student: your resource case manager at your boundary high school must contact our principal to be placed on the waiting list. You cannot attend an orientation session unless that has already happened.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- Travel on 106th South or 114th South
- Turn onto Jordan Gateway Drive (400 West).
- Turn west on 11010 South, (at stop light, which is by a building called Ag Credit).
- Turn south on the first left and Valley High School is the second building on your right.
